

COASTLANDS BIBLE READING PLAN

'AND ALL THESE THINGS WILL BE ADDED'

Provision is a recurring theme in the Bible that reflects God's care and faithfulness in meeting the needs of His people. There are at least 169 verses that speak of God's provision and the abundant blessings that we receive when we look to God for all our needs. Jesus assures us that when we prioritise God's Kingdom, our needs are met. This doesn't mean we will always get what we *want*, but it does mean that God will provide for our essential needs. God differentiates between our needs and our wants because He knows that where our treasure is, our heart is also (Matt 6:21). This world is not our home and part of what we need to do is shift our focus onto eternal life while still living this one.

We can trust His goodness, guidance, and shepherding care to do more for us than we could ever achieve on our own. He promises heavenly treasure, rest in divine provision and fulfilment of God's highest purpose for man – fellowship with Him and being part of His Kingdom. He invites us to take a leap of faith and trust in His care and provision.

Scripture: Take time to read over the passage.

Observations: Note down any personal observations.

Apply: How does it apply to your life?

Pray: Using your reflections

Continue to *seek first* the Kingdom and His righteousness as we go on in 2025. Perhaps taking more time to pray, either alone or with others is something you are stirred to continue. Maybe consider if continuing to fast on certain days or at certain times is something the Lord is calling you to do.

As we digest all He's been speaking over this time, note down anything significant you felt the Lord has said or revealed to you. If you believe there is something for the wider church, do pass onto one of the leaders.
